#### 1987

Lister Farm Sales, Massey Ferguson dealers for Gloucestershire, are looking to pull out of the industry and an agreement is reached with TFA. The companies continued to operate as TFA. Walter Wilder and Lister Farm Sales albeit all under the same family ownership.

Our Groundcare division is formed and soon after the Kubota franchise is added - this immediately accelerates our growth and Reading becomes the new hub for this business

Our Ashford branch opens its doors, initially focusing on Groundcare machinery before expanding and becoming a Kubota construction centre as well.

A service centre is opened on the outskirts of Bristol that grows steadily to become a fullyfledged branch along with sales and parts support.



Improving grassland requires various work. Opening up the sward in spring together with rolling are ways to raise the grassland quality.

For some years now much has been learnt about the effect of grass scarifying. The Grasmaster is a special scarifying harrow that removes all old grass, meadow grass, moss and weeds.

Molehills are levelled and dry dung pats are shattered. The massive cross-board leveller really works well levelling molehills and breaking clods when reseeding on ploughed ground to provide a level seed-bed.

The special spring steel harrow tines designed for grassland work are aggressive and remove the dead grass, dandelions and other broadleaf weeds. All tine fields are supported by a land wheel that permits precise ground contact. A mounted seed drill is an option. The fan is powered by a PTO shaft to ensure a constant and strong flow of air which gives an even seed distribution. This can be difficult to achieve with an electrically driven fan. The metering wheel is driven by a spoked land wheel, the seed is delivered down 8 tubes into the tine fields where the vibration of the tines spread the seed all over the ground.

For many dairy farmers, the Grasmaster is the optimum machine for grassland maintenance and re-seeding. Increased profits of 15% are not unusual in the first two years. Critical for this effect is the timing of the overseeding operation. Warm damp conditions make the germination more certain. The growth of the new grass is impeded in dry conditions or by late frosts.

The grass varieties are also critical and should match the climate, altitude and be the right mixture for the prevailing conditions.

## Kubota M4072 delivers time-saving versatili

For beef farmer, George Pothecary, the decision to replace his ageing tractor with a new Kubota M4072 from Lister Wilder was an easy one. His last Kubota had served him well for 17 years with exceptional reliability and he looked forward to enjoying the greater power and lift capacity of his new model, fitted with an LA1365 front loader. His high expectations have only been exceeded and he is delighted with every aspect of his new, slightly bigger workhorse.

With just over 100 acres and 50 head of Aberdeen Angus beef cattle to care for on his farm near Cricklade in north Wiltshire, George needs a robust and versatile tractor, capable of performing a wide range of tasks on a daily basis. His new Kubota M4072 is coping admirably with everything he asks of it, with the power, flexibility, and reliability he has come to count on.

Kubota's 74hp four-cylinder engine is guiet. economical and clean, and features highpressure fuel injection to deliver maximum power and torque. The compact design of the Kubota M4072 provides exceptional manoeuvrability – an important feature on George's farm at times of year when it is deployed extensively in confined livestock areas. The LA1365 front loader adds versatility and efficiency to the package.

"I couldn't fault the performance I am getting from my new Kubota tractor," says George. "The additional power compared to my old one makes a big difference and all the improvements that have been made over the years make for a very comfortable, productive and efficient vehicle.

"Being able to carry out different jobs without having to change implements all the time is a great time saver and makes life a lot easier. During the winter months the cattle are kept in. With a four-in-one bucket fitted to the front loader I can switch from carrying silage bales across the yard at feeding time, to cleaning

out the barn and laying straw, then pick up a scraper in the bucket to scrape the vard, all with the minimum effort.

"The controls are well-laid out and straightforward to use and the cab is comfortable with great visibility all round. The integration of the front loader with the tractor is remarkable," George enthuses. "The buttons and levers are conveniently placed and easy to use. It really is a joy to drive.

"Another brilliant thing about this tractor is its turning circle. The way they have designed the front axle means I can manoeuvre in and around confined spaces with no trouble at all."

In addition to the work carried out each day looking after the farm's livestock, the Kubota M4072 with its front loader has also proved its worth pulling out and transporting fallen trees and other materials across the farm. "We had a lot of elm trees on the farm," explains George. "These were killed off by Dutch Elm disease and, although we have taken out a lot of them over the years, we still have more to deal with. I used to use a grab on my old tractor and the heavy lifting was something that pushed it to the limit, but I can manage it all with the four-in-one bucket on my new Kubota. Its additional power and lifting capacity make light work of the job."

The relationship George has with Lister Wilder is both long and strong. George has worked his Cricklade farm for 45 years, initially with his father, then on his own since 1982. The Leighfields' dairy farm has 120 milking cows at the heart of a business that has expanded successfully into contracting. The family team offers its contracting customers a range of services including silage making using a self-propelled forager while also running a baler making round and square bales. Through a typical farming year, the Leighfields will also handle hay making, tanker-based slurry spreading and full ground works from ploughing through to cultivating, rolling and drilling. They also find time for hedge cutting and ditching.

Paul had long experience as a herdsman when he and Julie decided to apply for a tenancy to ensure their long-term future in the industry they love. They got the second tenancy they applied for - at Lyneham in Wiltshire - and worked there for ten years before moving to their current 150-acre farm at Upper Seagry in 2005. Further private lets takes their total holding to some 200 acres.

Soon, Richard and Edward piled their energy into the business and contracting became possible on a bigger scale. "Though I had worked for a long time as a herdsman, I have always been involved with machinery, so we did our own ground work from the start and took on silage making as one of a group of four farmers sharing one bit of kit," says Paul. "Nowadays, we work for dozens of farmer customers and cover a radius of up to 20 miles."

The sheer success of their contracting business soon posed them a big question. "We got to a point where we actually asked ourselves whether we should give up the cows because we needed more time," admits Paul. "But then we bought ourselves a milking parlour in a farm sale, got it re-galvanised and installed, and it's totally transformed our operation. We can now do the milking in an hour as opposed to two-and-a-half hours previously, which means we can be on site for a contracting customer by 8am when we need to be."

It adds up to a "ludicrously busy" schedule at key times of year but, with Julie able to run the milking parlour on her own if need be, they cope very well.

It does, however, mean that time spent around the farm is precious - and that's where the Kubota RTV comes in. "We had been after one for a time but never done much about it until Richard happened to meet Bryn Kinsman (Area Sales Manager) from Lister Wilder," says Paul. "Now I'm glad we did! We use it in the main to get around the farm setting out electric fencing, but the fact that it's road legal also means that it can be used to ferry spares when we are out contracting. The load capacity is great for fencing and ditching equipment, and for transporting fresh batteries for sheep keep."

He adds: "In the summer, we use it three of four times a day checking on sheep that we take in to graze. And if you have a cow that happens to calve out in the field we can simply pop the calf in the back to get it back to the farm with the mother following."

His conclusion: "We are delighted with it and very happy with the service Lister Wilder give us. We have known them for many years and they are always very helpful."
